Topic areas	<p>Primary curriculum.</p> <p>Maths- Addition and subtraction (within 20), 2-d and 3-d shape. RWI for children attending school.</p> <p>Topic we are looking at local features. Science -Everyday materials. RE – Islam. French – hobbies, likes and dislikes.</p>
Methods of teaching	<p>In school face to face teaching.</p> <p>Differentiated weekly work packs for Maths and English. White Rose online links to Autumn term tasks to revise and consolidate.</p> <p>Science and topic activity packs to go home.</p> <p>Education City Maths and English activities suited to ability.</p> <p>SALT and OT video meetings for children who are currently receiving support at school.</p>
Assessment/Feedback	<p>In school face to face teaching assessing in class in line with the Marking Policy.</p> <p>Telephone conversations with pupils and parents to support work.</p> <p>Feedback via email.</p> <p>Verbal feedback on work completed on brought into school. Work marked in line with the Marking Policy</p>
Communication with parents.	<p>Weekly welfare calls by a member of staff for Pythons, email support and communications. Member of staff for Pythons to deliver work and talk to parents and students not attending.</p> <p>Discussing work and any potential safeguarding issue.</p> <p>Completing Welfare log of all calls and contact made to parents.</p> <p>Offering laptop support for those pupils that need it. Conducting and organising of Annual Reviews remotely. SALT and OT sessions video sessions.</p>
