On site work experience

In line with the units completed by the students, on site work experience is used throughout to strengthen the skills the pupils have acquired and apply to real-life settings. Projects set up vary in accordance to surveying. Projects from tap replacements, decorating, landscape gardening to tiling are examples of projects carried out in the past.

Level 1 Health and Safety in the Construction Environment

Year 11 Rowhill students have the opportunity to take part in a one-day training course with "Outreach tuition" Maidstone. On completion they will receive a Level 1 Health and Safety in the Construction environment qualification.

This Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a construction environment is accepted to apply for the Construction Skills certification scheme (CSCS) green labourer card.

CSCS Labourer Card Test

On Completion of the Level 1 H&S Award, Rowhill students will then have the opportunity to do one test to CSCS Labourer card test at the nearest test centre.

On completion this will allow you to work on site alongside a trader as a labourer.
