Tasks available to choose are:

Drain a radiator and bleed, gutter repair/cleaning working, replace broken tiles, replace a 3 pin plug, understand socket and light fitting circuits, painting and decorating, wallpapering, put up shelving, brick pointing, silicone around a sink, change tap washers, put together flat pack furniture, chisel out a door hinge and hang a door, plastering patch work repair.

In addition to the above, as an extension project, students will have the opportunity throughout the year to also carry out additional onsite maintenance repairs which you will come across in a home.
