Jessica was born in Sheffield on the 28th January 1986 to parents Vinnie and Alison. She has a younger sister called Carmel.

At a young age Jessica and her sister were introduced to athletics. In the school holidays they would attend local athletics camps. At the age of 13 Jessica had her first coaching session with Toni Minichiello. Shortly after she joined the City of Sheffield Athletics Club who she still represents today. Since 2000, Jessica's progression through the junior and youth competitions showed that she was a talent for the future.

Since University Jessica has been a full time athlete. After winning a bronze medal in the 2005 Commonwealth Games, she improved her scores and won Gold at the 2009 World Championships.
