Prodigy and Education City. Video calls with pupils to discuss work, progress and set tasks.
Assessment/Feedback	In school face to face teaching assessing in class in line with the Marking Policy. Telephone conversations with pupils and parents to support and mark work. Written feedback and next steps on MS Teams. Reports from prodigy and Education City on pupils' interaction and attainment. Verbal feedback to pupils on work completed and brought into school. Work marked in line with the Marking Policy Notebook created for T3 to use for work and questions.
Communication with parents.	Weekly welfare calls, email support and communications. Discussing work and any potential safeguarding issue. Completing Welfare log of all calls made to parents. Offered food parcels and laptops to support pupils that need it. Email and or phone calls to parents to check wellbeing and attainment. Conducting and organising of Annual Reviews remotely.
