<p>Topic areas</p>	<p>English: Working through the AQA Step Up to GCSE program. Pupils follow a project based three year rolling programme. Each project is based around a Topic: Term 3: Adventure, Term 4: Heroism, Term 5: exploring, Term 6: Persecution.</p> <p>Specification of Step-Up to GCSE: A01: Identify and interpret explicit and implicit information and ideas. A02: Explain, comment on and analyse how writers use language and structure to achieve effects and influence readers, using relevant subject terminology to support views. A03: Compare writers' ideas and perspectives. A04: Evaluate texts critically and support this with appropriate textual references. A05: Communicate clearly, effectively and imaginatively, selecting and adapting tone, style and register for different forms, purposes and audiences. Organise information and ideas, using structural and grammatical features to support coherence and cohesion of texts. A06: Use vocabulary and sentence structures for clarity purpose and effect, with accurate spelling and punctuation. A07: Demonstrate presentation skills. A08: Listen and respond appropriately to spoken language. A09: Use spoken English effectively in speeches and presentations.</p>
