Headlines

2019 was a good year for our small cohort of only six Year 11 leavers.

In 2019:

- Students achieved 82 Level 1 passes.
- Students left Rowhill with an incredible average of 9 qualifications, an increase of 200% from 2017
- 66% of students achieved 5 qualifications including English and maths
- 100% of students achieved an English and maths qualification, an incredible improvement on the previous year.
- Level 2 passes improved on the previous 2 years.
- 100% of students achieved a vocational qualification.
- 100% of students achieved a nationally recognised qualification.
