

Analysis of Exam Results June 2020

Headlines

2020 was another good year for our year 11 leavers. This is the first year that we have included our ACP pupils. Most of our ACP pupils join us late in their secondary education at year 10 or year 11.

- Students achieved 42 level 1 passes up from 34 in 2019.
- Students left with an average of 7 qualifications.
- Highest number of level 2 passes (16) more than double the previous years.
- 94% of pupils (Including ACP pupils) achieved a Maths and English qualification.
- 100% of pupils achieved a vocational qualification.
- Every pupil achieved a qualification.
