Headlines

Despite the issues raised by the pandemic it has been another good year for our year 11 leavers. We have included our Alternative Curriculum Programme (ACP) pupils that join us in years 10 or 11.

- Students achieved a total of 179 passes.
- The main school pupils averaged 8.8 passes.
- Students achieved the highest number of Level 2 passes this year with 33- more than double the previous year's total.
- 89.5% of students achieved 5 passes or more.
- 89.5 % of students achieved an English and Maths qualification.
- For the third year in succession 100% of pupils achieved a qualification.
- 100% of students achieved a vocational qualification.
