Intent	Raise confidence and self-esteem to enable students to attend school on a full timetable and feel safe and happy so they are able to come to school every day. To be able to access the curriculum which has been differentiated to their needs. To provide stimulating and exciting learning opportunities which involve lots of kinesthetic learning activities as well as learning outside the classroom opportunities. To develop social skills and a sense of community through interventions and class celebrations to enable positive interactions with peers leading to forming friendships and to socialise successfully. To trust adults and develop role models they can aspire to be like.
Implementation	Class celebrations and positive reward system. A differentiated curriculum which includes practical activities, learning outside the classroom opportunities and personalised learning. Interventions linked to pupil asset data as well as students' SEMH and CI needs. Zones of Regulation to self-manage behaviours. Regular communication with parents/carers
Impact	Class Charts, attendance, Boxall and Pupil Asset data. Students to make the expected academic progress as well as being settled and happy at school. Students to interact positively with staff and students and respect the school and the school rules. Students to be able to manage their behaviour when in the 'Red Zone' and use their 'tool kit' of how to return mostly independently to the 'green zone'. Can achieve an attendance above 90%.
Transition	To transition smoothly into their new Primary Class with minimal problems as social skills, attitudes to learning and feeling a part of the school community will be embedded. To understand trusted staff are still accessible to them if they need support even if they are in a different class.
